- 6. I entered the United States for the first time after my 26th birthday. Attach copies of immigration documents such as a date-stamped passport, visa, or I-94.
- 7. I entered the United States before age 26 on a valid non-immigrant visa, and remained in that status until age 26. Attach a date-stamped copy of your visa.
- 8. None of the above accurately describes my situation. Attach an appeal (see directions below) that explains why you did not register.

### Selective Service Appeal

Write a personal statement that explains the circumstances related to your non-registration. Sign and date the appeal, and include your University ID number. Submit the appeal to any One Stop Student Services location. A committee will review the appeal and notify you of the decision within 10 business days.
